## WINTER TRITICALE

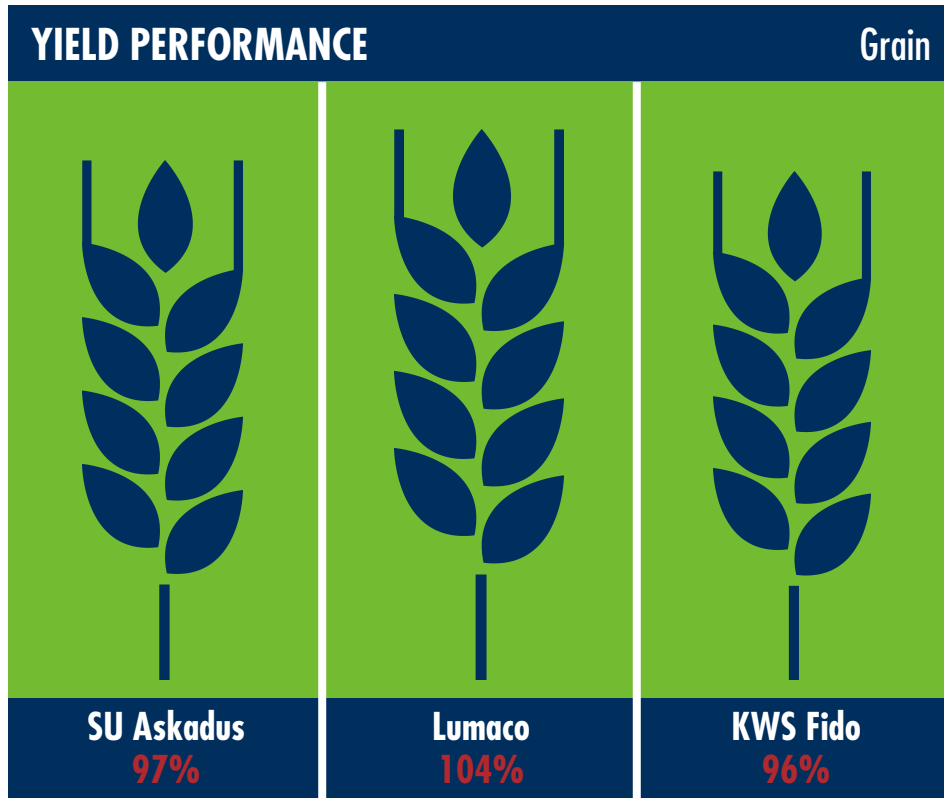
SU Askadus has been in the market for a couple of years. It is a reliable winter triticale with exceptional standing power.

It has good protein and specific weight and can be used for grain or forage.

SU Askadus had a very good year in 2025 with a grain yield of 101% in official trials.

Its smaller stature looks to be slightly more drought tolerant as this was also noticed in 2022.

- ➔ SU Askadus is a very reliable variety with excellent straw strength.
- ➔ SU Askadus is a slightly shorter variety than some on the market.
- ➔ SU Askadus has good disease resistance and excellent quality.
- ➔ SU Askadus has favourable traits required for a low input system.
