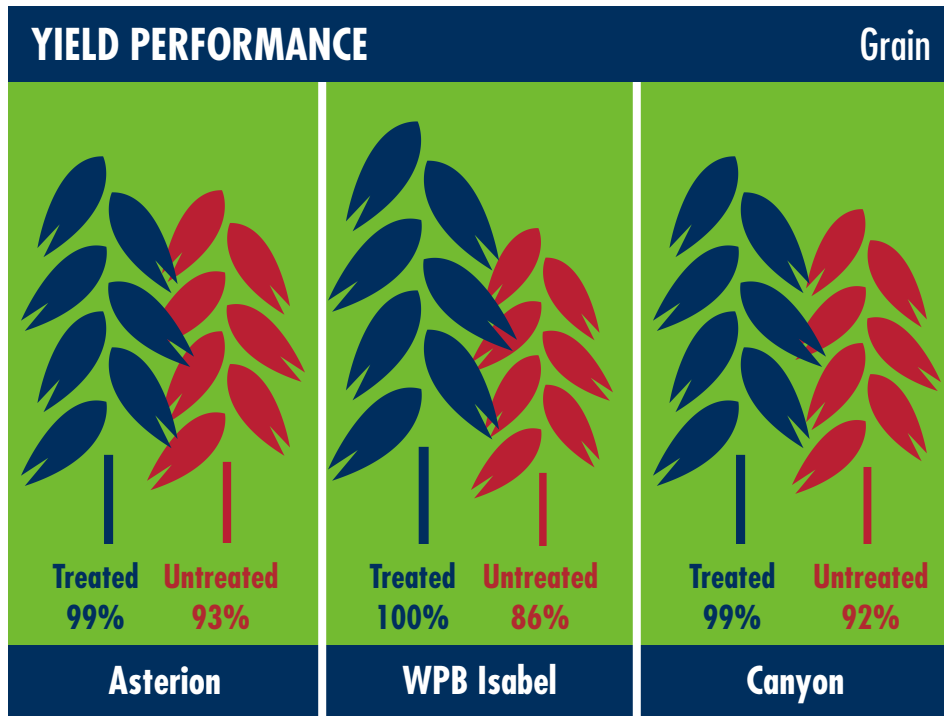
Asterion is making its mark in the organic sector. It is a variety with an excellent balance of yield and quality.

➔ Spring oats provide a break crop in the rotation and give an opportunity to 'clean up' the seedbed over winter.

➔ Modify seedrates to the seedbed quality and drilling date.

➔ Drill your Spring Oats as soon as conditions allow, into a fine, firm seedbed, drilling late February/ Early March is worth 0.5 t/ha as compared to drilling 4 weeks later.
