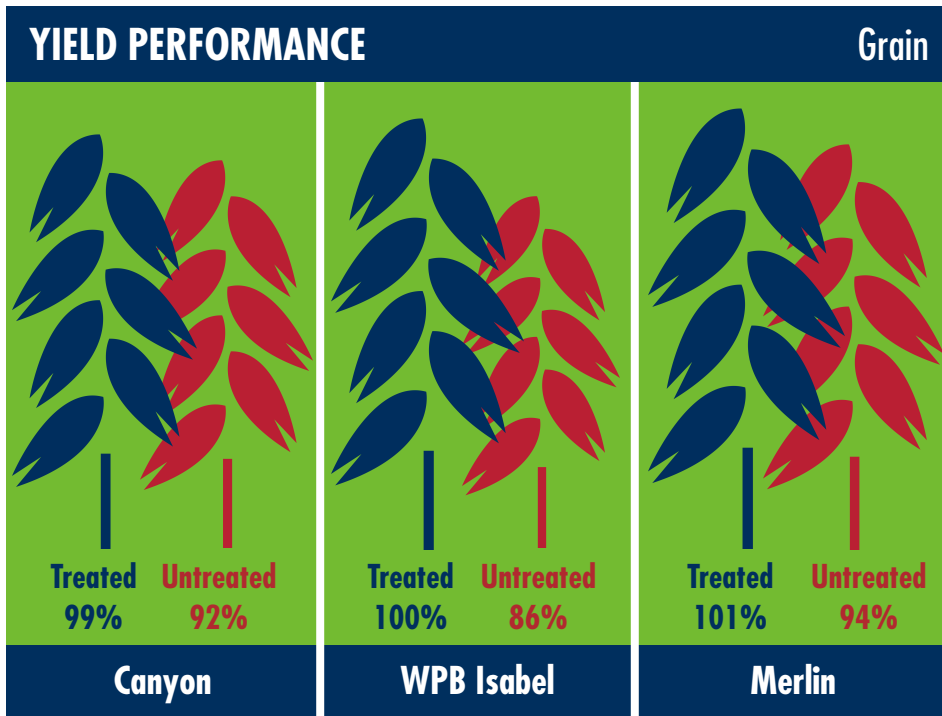
Canyon has been present in the Recommended List since 2011. Its standout feature has been consistency over that long period.

➔ Spring oats provide a break crop in the rotation and give an opportunity to 'clean up' the seedbed over winter.

➔ Modify seedrates to the seedbed quality and drilling date.

➔ Drill your Spring Oats as soon as conditions allow, into a fine, firm seedbed, drilling late February/ Early March is worth 0.5 t/ha as compared to drilling 4 weeks later.
