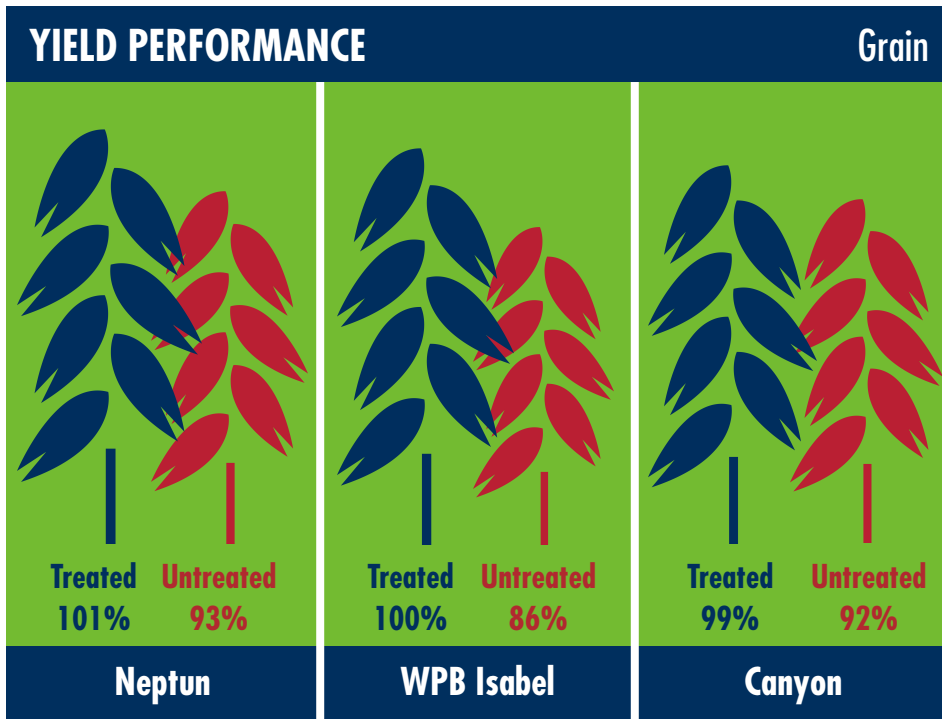
Neptun is the spring oat with the highest quality. This combined with strong yield makes it an attractive variety for both the grower and the miller.

Neptun inherits these traits from its parent lines, Lion (for quality) x Delfin (for yield).

Neptun also boasts good agronomics with leading resistance to mildew and good resistance to brown rust.

This high quality package also comes with early maturity. In trials we have seen it excel in the South.

- ➔ Neptun is the number one spring oat for Quality.
- ➔ Neptun has the highest specific weight and kernel content on the list.
- ➔ Neptun has excellent disease resistance.
- ➔ Neptun is an early maturing variety with strong yield.

AHDB DL 2026

➔ Spring oats provide a break crop in the rotation and give an opportunity to 'clean up' the seedbed over winter.

GRAIN QUALITY	
Specific Weight (kg/hl)	53.9
Kernel Content (%)	74
Screenings (% through 2mm)	2.2

➔ Modify seedrates to the seedbed quality and drilling date.

DISEASE (1-9)	
Mildew	8
Crown Rust	5

➔ Drill your Spring Oats as soon as conditions allow, into a fine, firm seedbed, drilling late February/ Early March is worth 0.5 t/ha as compared to drilling 4 weeks later.
